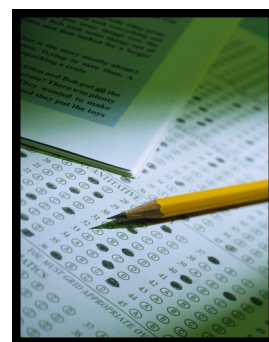
## PSAT'S - ACCUPLACER - ASVAB

On Wednesday, Oct. 12th, approximately 60% of juniors took the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT). This test is great practice for the SAT Reasoning Test—used by many colleges to gauge student academic progress. Juniors may qualify for National Merit Scholarships. All students will receive comprehensive feedback with their test results, which are usually distributed in December.

Also on Oct. 12th, 40% of our Juniors took the ACCUPLACER or ASVAB tests. The purpose of these tests is to provide students with useful information about academic skills in math, English, and reading. The results of the assessment in conjunction with academic background, goals and interests are used by counselors to determine

course selection. Community colleges and some Maine Universities are using the results for placement in college courses.
